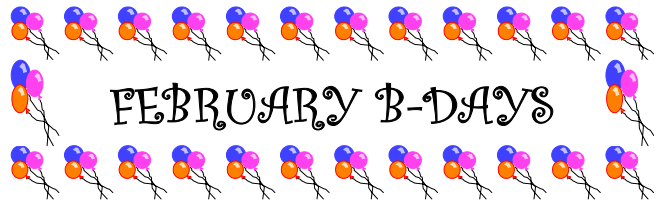

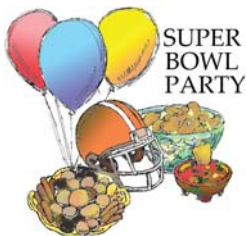
## Super Bowl Party February 7
